# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

# HOW WILL THE DAY BE STRUCTURED?

Participants will receive 2.5 hours of on-ice instruction and 3+ hours of Academic Support.

# CAN MY CHILD PARTICIPATE IF THEY DON'T PLAY HOCKEY?

No, this program is intended for squirts, peewees and bantams, grades 5 - 9.

# WHAT IS THE COST OF THIS PROGRAM?

The cost of the program is \$150/day (\$18.75/hour). Registration will be by week. More information on payment details to come.

#### WHEN WILL THE PROGRAM START?

The program will start in the first few weeks of September. This will be finalized once we receive more information from the school districts.

# HOW MANY DAYS A WEEK WILL THE PROGRAM RUN?

The program will run Monday – Friday and the participants will be able to choose 2, 3, 4 or 5 days based on availability and school structures. More information to come on this.

# HOW WILL THE ICE SESSIONS WORK IF MY CHILD HAS ZOOM CLASSES AT THOSE TIMES?

Students will be split into groups based on school structures and schedules. Once we have more information from the school systems, we will be able to provide more details on the schedule.

# WHAT WILL THE ON-ICE PORTION CONSIST OF?

On-ice time will focus on skating, puck control, shooting, and passing through a series of specially designed drills. Once on the ice, participants will be split into groups by age and ability. Full hockey equipment is required.

#### HOW WILL THE OFF-ICE PORTION BE STRUCTURED?

Participants must bring their school work to the program. The teacher will check in with your child and ensure that the participant is utilizing their academic time to the fullest. Teachers will provide general academic support, answer questions, and keep the participants on task. Teachers will not be providing their own curriculum.

Masks will be worn at all times by participants and staff. Each child will have their own desk 6ft from all other participants. The facility is cleaned throughout the day and each night.

#### WHERE WILL MY CHILD PUT THEIR EQUIPMENT ON?

Locker rooms will continue to be closed for this age group- we will be following the protocols set at the start of phase 2, using properly spaced chairs in lobby areas.

#### WILL THERE BE A "DROP-IN" OPTION?

There will not be a "drop-in" option. This will limit the amount of people that your child will come into contact with.

#### ARE MEALS AND SNACKS PROVIDED?

No. Participants are required to provide their own lunch and snacks.

#### WILL PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE JERSEYS?

Yes, each participant will receive a jersey.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHILD'S SCHOOL SCHEDULE CHANGES?

You will receive a pro-rated refund for what you have paid up to that point.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF MY CHILD OR A HOUSEHOLD FAMILY MEMBER BECOMES INFECTED WITH COVID?

You will be refunded for the weeks your child has missed. You will also be asked to confirm a negative test after 2 weeks of quarantine.

#### WHAT HAPPENS IF WARRIOR ICE ARENA CLOSES?

All participants will receive a pro-rated refund from the last day of the program.

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
