

FACILITY PROTOCOLS

ARE FACE COVERINGS REQUIRED?

Guests: At all times. **Participants:** At all times except on the ice surface during level 1 play.

WHAT CAN TAKE PLACE ON THE ICE?

Levels 1, 2 and 3 activities are now available for both youth and adult programming. We will continue with in-house programming and private ice rentals.

WILL LOCKER ROOMS BE OPEN?

Locker Rooms will be open at 50% capacity. Showers will remain closed. Youth participants will continue to get ready before entering the facility. No hockey bags permitted for youth participants. If a guest enters with a hockey bag, the bag will not be permitted to remain in the hallway and the parent/guardian must take it with them.

WILL SPECTATORS BE ALLOWED TO WATCH A PROGRAM?

Spectators will be limited to 1 parent/guardian per youth participant. Siblings are not permitted to accompany the 1 parent/guardian. Spectators for adult programs (21+) are not allowed at this time.

ARE NON-ESSENTIAL VISITORS ALLOWED?

Non-essential visitors will not be permitted. If you have questions or are looking to purchase merchandise, please call the arena and speak to a staff member. All guests and participants that enter the facility are required to complete our digital contact tracing form.

WILL GARAGE PARKING BE AVAILABLE?

Yes, garage parking will still be available with normal self-validation. For drop-offs, please use the Guest Street Entrance.

WILL CONCESSIONS BE OPEN?

Concessions will be open with a limited menu and hours. Water fountains will remain closed. Water filling stations will be open.

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ON-ICE GUIDELINES

Hockey Levels Explained:

Level 1 - Individuals socially distanced at all times- no-contact workouts, skills work, and drills.

Level 2- Competitive Practices (intra-team games)

Level 3- Competitions (different teams playing each other)

GENERAL ON-ICE GUIDELINES

- Program participants will be required to maintain 6 feet of distance from one another.
- Shared water bottles will not be available. All participants must bring their own water bottle, clearly labeled with first and last name.
- Face coverings are required to be worn at all times by coaches, even on the ice spaced more than 6 feet from others.
- There will be separate entrance and exit points on the ice.
- All players on the benches are required to maintain social distance. Overflow will be asked to stand off the bench area in designated spaces.
- **Level 1 Play:** Participants are required to wear a mask before getting on the ice and upon exiting the ice. Masks are not required on the ice during play. Participants are required to bring their masks with them on the bench. We recommend bringing a baggy clearly labeled with their name.
- **During Level 2 & 3 Play:** Participants will be required to wear a mask at all times. Masks must be worn when sitting on the bench and during face offs. Masks can be lowered during regular play.
- 1 person per penalty box. If second penalty occurs, the player will serve their penalty on their bench.

YOUTH ONLY: Please label the front of the participants helmet with their name to allow for coaches to easily read names while keeping 6 foot distancing.

ADULT ONLY: Checking and unnecessary contact are not permitted on the ice. If locker room use is permitted, please adhere to the capacity limits per room and exit the locker room within 15 minutes of the end of your session. Showering is not permitted and absolutely no congregating.
